




PREMIS Data Dictionary for Preservation Metadata, Version 3.0

The PREMIS Data Dictionary and its supporting documentation is a comprehensive, practical resource for implementing preservation metadata in digital archiving systems. The Data Dictionary is built on a data model that defines five entities: Intellectual Entities, Objects, Events, Rights, and Agents. Each semantic unit defined in the Data Dictionary is a property of one of the entities in the data model.







BESCHRIJVING

[Willem Duys](#) presenteert jarenlang op zondagochtend *Muziekmozaïek*, een programma met easy listening en middle-of-the-roadmuziek: zachte tonen, soft jazz en fluwelen gezang om bij te ontwaken.

Zoetgevooid kondigt Duys zijn favoriete platen aan, veelal van bevriende musici: "Goedemorgen trouwe muziekvrienden, fijn dat u weer allemaal aan het toestel zit. Ik heb hier een prachtige schijf in handen...".

Op 27 juni 1999 presenteert Duys voor de allerlaatste maal zijn befaamde radioprogramma op de zondagochtend. De gevolgen van een herseninfarct dat [hij](#) een jaar eerder opliep, nopen hem tot dit besluit: Duys vindt dat zijn stem onder dit voorval geleden heeft.
